# Pace of Play Tips, Handicaps & Golf Course Information

Philadelphia Country Club strives to provide an enjoyable golfing experience for all Members and Guests. In order to provide this, we ask that each player be ready to play when it is his or her turn as all rounds at Philadelphia Country Club should be played in four hours or less.

Here are a few tips on how to play "Ready Golf":

- During an informal round of golf, do not follow the honor system on the tee box at the expense of faster play. When arriving to the tee box, ready players should play away if the player with the honor is not ready.
- When you think your golf ball may be lost or out of play, always hit a provisional ball. This will save you time in the event the original ball is unrecoverable.
- If you are well clear of others in your group, play ahead when ready.
- When you arrive at the green, read the line of your putt and be prepared when it is your turn. Always be by your ball and ready in case the person who has the honor is not ready to play.
- Most importantly, keep pace with the group ahead of you.

Following these tips will help in saving even one or two minutes on each hole. This will help make the golfing experience at Philadelphia Country Club more enjoyable for everyone.

## Handicap Posting & Equitable Stroke Control

Over the years, many refinements have been made to the USGA Handicap System including the procedure of adjusting individual hole scores for handicap purposes. Equitable Stroke Control (ESC) sets a maximum number that a player can post on any hole depending on the player's Course Handicap.

The ESC procedure is as follows:

Course Handicap	Maximum Score on Any Hole
9 or lower	Double Bogey
10 through 19	7
20 through 29	8
30 through 39	9
40 or higher	10

# G O L F P R I V I L E G E S

---

As Golf Members of Philadelphia Country Club this privilege comes with an expectation from the Club and fellow Members that each individual will embrace the Core Values listed below to help make the Golfing experience the best that it can be and uphold the traditions and values of the Club.

- We play 18 holes in 4 hours or less
- We take pride in the golf course
- We support our caddie program
- We treat Staff and other Members with respect and integrity
- We uphold the traditions of Philadelphia Country Club

Golf Members are expected to embrace the PCC culture and adhere to all Club guidelines. Failure to do so will be evaluated by the Golf and Member Issues Committees. Thank you for all of your support and enjoy the game.

**1. Golf Privileges** A Resident, Senior or Intermediate Member with a Full Golf Privilege has unlimited play on any course throughout the year. See **#14 Exceptions**. A Resident Member with a Full Golf Privilege, who becomes a Non-Resident Member with Non-Resident Golf Privileges, will resume a Full Resident Golf Privilege should he/she return to Resident Membership. The number of Members entitled to Full Golf Privileges will be established by the Board of Governors. Golf Members' children ages 21 to 24, may elect to purchase a Golf Privilege to play an unlimited number of rounds on the Spring Mill and Centennial courses. See **#3i Golf Rules**.

**2. The Limited Golf Privilege** was available only to new Resident Members elected in fiscal 2015 and 2016. The privilege entitles the Member to fifteen (15) family combined rounds, a Family Driving Range Privilege and the ability to register for events and tournaments, based on availability. All rounds including Tournament, Junior, Ladies', and Men's rounds played on both the Spring Mill and Centennial courses will count towards the 15 limit. One Member of the family other than a child will need to be designated as the primary Golf Member. Spouse restrictions are in effect and Ladies can elect to play in Tuesday and Thursday Lady Groups by paying applicable fees. The Member will need to decide on a Full Golf Privilege within 3 years of election to Membership or forfeit their initial investment.

**3. Temporary Relinquishment of a Golf Privilege** A Resident, Senior, Non-Resident or Resident Non-Voting Member may temporarily relinquish (as opposed to canceling) said Member's Golf Privilege to be effective on November 1<sup>st</sup> of a fiscal year as long as written application for such has been received by the Member Issues Committee no later than March 31<sup>st</sup> of the fiscal year. If approved, the Member will be billed 25% of the Full Golf Annual Dues, and will be limited (as will be said Member's Spouse and Children) to the Privilege afforded to a **Member without Golf Privilege**. Later,

said Member may make written application to the Member Issues Committee for the reinstatement of said Member's Golf Privilege and, upon approval, said Member's Golf Privilege will be reinstated when the next Golf Privilege becomes available. If a Full Golf Privilege is available, it will be reinstated immediately upon payment of the appropriate Golf Dues. Should there be more Members who make application for reinstatement of Golf Privileges than there are Golf Privileges available, then reinstatements will be extended to Members in the chronological order in which the applications were received. Driving range and practice facility access is included.

**4. Member without Golf Privilege & their Children** Any Member without a Golf Privilege, their Spouse and/or Children up to their 25<sup>th</sup> birthday may play Golf a combined total of five (5) times during the fiscal year by paying the applicable greens fee. Play is prohibited on the Spring Mill course between 11:30am and 1:30pm Tuesday through Friday, and prior to 1:30pm on Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays.

**a. The Child Golf Privilege** Children under the age of 21 of Non-Golf Members and Members who have placed their Golf on Temporary Relinquishment may elect to purchase a Child Golf Privilege for one-eighth of the prevailing Full Golf Annual Dues. Tee time restrictions are the same as a Spouse of a Golf Member and the child must be certified to play the Spring Mill Course.

**5. Non-Resident Member with Golf Privilege** The Member may play ten (10) times during the fiscal year with no greens fee.

**6. Spousal Golf Privilege** A Spouse of a Golf Member, upon payment of the applicable Golf dues, obtains a Spousal Golf Privilege. **Please refer to Golf Rules, Section 3e - Tee Time Restrictions** for restrictions on **Members with Spousal Golf Privileges**. The Spouse is also subject to the same restrictions that are applicable to the Member's class of membership.

**7. Intermediate Golf** Intermediate Members ages 25-34 may obtain a Full Golf Privilege provided they pay the applicable fees. An Intermediate applying for Resident or Non-Resident Membership at age 35, who had a Golf Privilege as an Intermediate Member, will retain the same Privilege when he/she is accepted as a Resident or Non-Resident Member by paying the applicable fees. An Intermediate who once attains a Golf Privilege through a parent will not lose such Privilege regardless of a change in the parent's Golf Privilege status.

Pending a Golf Waiting List, Intermediate Members may obtain a Golf Privilege provided that they are proposed for Membership by their 25<sup>th</sup> birthday, and they are a Child of a Member who has a Golf Privilege. All other applicants for Intermediate Membership will be placed on the Golf Wait List as of the date of their Intermediate election.

**8. Assignment of Right to Play to a Spouse** A Member may assign his/her right to play in times restricted to Members only to his/her Spouse. By application to the Golf Committee, and the signing of the appropriate form, the Member will transfer his/her right to play during said times to the Spouse, and the Member will assume the Spousal playing rights if a Spousal Golf Privilege is retained. The assignment would be for the fiscal year (11/1 - 10/31), and will remain in effect until rescinded in writing by the Member.

## 9. Senior Members

- a. All Primary Golf Members who are 80 years old or older, as of the beginning of the Club's fiscal year (November 1), will receive a 50% reduction in Golf Dues.
- b. All Primary Golf Members who are 90 years old or older, as of the beginning of the Club's fiscal year (November 1), will receive a 100% reduction in Golf Dues.
- c. Any Member without a Golf Privilege who has attained the age of 85 is eligible to play ten (10) nine hole rounds of Golf instead of five (5) eighteen hole rounds of Golf. The nine hole fee, including golf car, for Spring Mill is \$84.00. The nine hole fee, including golf car, for Centennial is \$64.00.

**10. Golf Waiting List Privilege** In the event the number of allotted Full Golf Privileges is reached, a Golf Wait List will be instituted. Members on the Golf Wait List will fall under the following rules. A Resident, Senior or Intermediate Member on the Waiting List may play fifteen (15) times during the Golf season (April 1 - October 31) by paying the applicable greens fee.

1. They may only play five (5) times on the weekends or Holidays, and no more than ten (10) rounds may be on the Spring Mill Course with the following exceptions: play is prohibited on Spring Mill between 11:30am and 1:30pm Tuesday through Friday.
2. A Member on the Golf Waiting List has unlimited Golf in the **off-season** by paying the applicable greens fee.
3. When a Member's Child, under 21 years of age, plays a round with the Member on the Spring Mill Course, there is no greens fee for the Child; and only the parent's round counts towards the fifteen (15) times allowed. If the under 25 Child plays without their parent on the Spring Mill Course, they are subject to the same restrictions; there will be a greens fee and it counts as one (1) round towards the fifteen (15) times allowed. Golf Wait List Members children ages 21 to 24, may elect to purchase a Junior Golf Privilege to play an unlimited number of rounds on the Spring Mill and Centennial courses.

**11. Golf Wait List Procedure** Golf Privileges are offered in strict chronological order. Members who wish to obtain a Golf Privilege will be placed on the bottom of the list, and be billed 50% of the prevailing applicable Golf Privilege Fee. This fee will be applied to future Golf Privilege Fees and is non-refundable. Golf Wait List Members offered a Golf Privilege who do not accept will be removed from the Golf Wait List, and the money previously paid will be forfeited. Members offered a Golf Privilege who accept, will be billed the balance of the prevailing Golf Privilege Fee.

**12. Non-Resident Member on Golf Waiting List** The Member may play ten (10) times during the fiscal year by paying the applicable greens fee, with the following exceptions: Play is prohibited on the Spring Mill between 11:30am and 1:30pm, Tuesday through Friday. Only five (5) of these rounds may be on weekends or Holidays.

**13. Driving Range Privilege** Individuals without a Golf Privilege and who wish to have access to the Driving Range and Pitching Green for practice will need to purchase a Range Privilege each season. Individuals without a Range Privilege will still have

access to the Range only for lessons and warm up prior to playing one of their five (5) rounds. Members do not need a Driving Range Privilege to use the Practice Hole.

Please note that Full Golf, Spouse and Temporary Relinquished with a Golf Privilege have full use privileges of the Driving Range and practice facilities.

**14. Exceptions** All playing Privileges noted above may be preempted by special events or previously scheduled tournaments.



# G O L F R U L E S

---

**1. Golf Season** The official Golf season begins April 1 and ends October 31. All rules and regulations of the Club and Courses are in effect during this period.

**2. Starting Times** Starting times are available Tuesday through Friday from 8am until 3pm, and on Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays from 7:10am until 3pm (subject to change of season). Starting times are available to be reserved eight (8) days in advance beginning at 8am by logging on to the Club's website or by calling the Golf Shop. All Members must tee off at the time reserved, or wait until the next available tee time opening. Centennial will open one hour after the Spring Mill Course, and tee off will be on a first come, first serve basis. **In 2017 on Tuesdays and Thursdays during the months of June, July and August Centennial will open, on a trial basis, 15 minutes after sunrise for walking only.**

Tee times will be blocked for all Club tournaments, Tuesday and Thursday Ladies' events, Tuesday and Thursday Raiders' events and weekday outings.

A foursome may not contain more than two (2) "Do Not Add" (DNA) or "To Be Determined" (TBD). Any DNA's or TBD's that are not filled in by the Member making the tee time reservation two days prior to the tee off time will be automatically opened for other Members who may wish to sign up.

The Golf Committee reserves the right to adjust these restrictions as necessary to fully utilize this system.

## 3. Tee Time Restrictions

- a. **Golf Members** are restricted to one Guest per foursome on Saturdays until 10am, and one Guest per foursome on Sundays and Holidays until 9am.
- b. **Tuesday Ladies** have full use of the Spring Mill Course on Tuesdays until 11am.
- c. **Thursday Ladies** have full use of one nine on the Spring Mill Course on Thursdays until 10:30am.
- d. **Temporary Golf Relinquishment Members** who have put their Golf membership on relinquishment, their Spouse and/or Children may play Golf a combined total of five (5) times during the fiscal year by paying the applicable greens fee. They are prohibited to play on the Spring Mill course between 11:30am and 1:30pm Tuesday through Friday, or prior to 1:30pm on Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays. **Exception if a tee time is available on a Saturday, Sunday, or Holiday after 11:30am, 24 hours in advance, the Member can call in to the Golf Shop to reserve a tee time, limited to once a month.**

- e. **Spousal Golf Privilege** Members may not play the Spring Mill Course before 10am on Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays unless the right to play during these times has been assigned to the Spouse by the Member.
- f. **Members or Non-Resident Members without a Golf Privilege, their Spouses and/or Children** may play Golf a combined total of five (5) times during the fiscal year by paying the applicable greens fee. They are prohibited to play on the Spring Mill Course between 11:30am and 1:30pm Tuesday through Friday, or prior to 1:30pm on Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays.
- g. **Non-Resident Members with a Golf Privilege** are subject to the same restrictions as Members with a Golf Privilege, and may play at any time on the Spring Mill Course provided it is available, but are restricted to ten (10) rounds per fiscal year. If a Member temporarily relinquishes his or her Golf Privilege, they may play the Spring Mill Course five (5) times per year upon payment of the applicable greens fee.
- h. **Children (under 21 years of age) of Golf Members** are subject to the same tee time restrictions as a Spousal Golf Member and may play the Spring Mill Course only if they are certified and take a golf car or Caddie before 2:30pm. They may play the Centennial anytime.
- i. **Children (Ages 21 to 24) of All Members** who want full access to the Golf Courses must pay a Golf Privilege Fee of 25% of the Full Golf Annual Dues. This will allow play on the Spring Mill Course (during Spousal times) and unlimited play on the Centennial Course without paying a greens fee. Otherwise, they are limited to five rounds and subject to greens fees.
- j. **Children (under the age of 21) of Golf Wait List Members** must pay the applicable greens fee when playing the Spring Mill Course. They may play an unlimited number of rounds on the Centennial Course without any greens fee.
- k. **Golf Wait List Members** may not play the Spring Mill Course between 11:30am and 1:30pm, Tuesday through Friday. They may play fifteen (15) times during the Golf Season (April 1 - October 31) by paying the applicable greens fee. They may only play five (5) times per year on weekends and Holidays. Opening Day, Closing Day, Fall Classic, and the Men's Invitational do not count against these five rounds.

**4. Practice Facilities** There is a Practice Range adjacent to the 1<sup>st</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> tees available to those with the Driving Range Privilege noted on page 6, #13. Practice balls will be on the Range during the hours it is open. Practice balls that are white are conventional range balls, practice balls that are yellow are reduced flight balls (80%). **PRACTICE BALLS MAY NOT BE HIT OVER THE BOUNDARY FENCE!** Those in violation of this rule will be subject to a restriction, and possible loss of Golf Privilege by the Golf Committee. Practice balls are the property of the Club and should not be removed from the Practice Facility. Please note yellow balls can still be hit over the fence when well struck. Please ensure the safety of others by monitoring proper distance control.

There is a Practice Green for pitching and bunker shots and a Practice Putting Green. Practice balls are provided and may be used on both Greens. Practice balls are the property of the Club and should not be removed from the Practice Facility. Players may use their own practice balls. Pitching to the Practice Putting Green is not allowed. Chip shots are permitted.

There is also a Practice Hole available to our Members between holes 13 and 14 on the Mill Nine. To utilize this feature, there is an access road off Lafayette Road at the Club's maintenance entrance. Extreme caution should be used as there will be golfers, golf cars and maintenance machinery near this road. Players will need to provide their own golf balls or contact the Golf Shop to pickup a shag bag which will need to be returned. Please note all golf balls should be picked up when finished at the Practice Hole.

Children must be certified by the Golf Staff to hit balls on the Driving Range without adult supervision. Children under the age of 18 will not be permitted to use the Driving Range between the hours of 11:30am - 1:30pm Tuesday through Friday, or Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays between the hours of 7am - 10am, unless they are supervised by an adult.

**Anyone who is inappropriately attired will not be allowed to use the Practice Facilities (See #12, on page 13, for attire guidelines).**

The Driving Range will close early Wednesdays and Sundays so that the Range can be picked completely for mowing the next morning. It may also be closed at other times approved by the Golf Professional. The Outside Staff will monitor usage and may restrict or adjust access as necessary.

Opening: Tuesday-Sunday: 30 minutes before the 1<sup>st</sup> available tee time of the day.

Closing: Tuesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday: 30 minutes after sunset (Members can hit balls until they can't see anymore).

Wednesdays & Sundays:    April, 6:30pm  
   May 1 through Labor Day, 7:45 pm  
   Day after Labor Day until September 30, 6:30pm  
   October, 5:30pm

Closed: Every Monday except Monday Holidays when it will be closed on Tuesdays of that week.

Note: On Memorial Day & Labor Day the Sunday closing time will be in effect on the Holiday instead of the Sunday.

Driving Range Mat: On days when the range is mats only, all balls should be hit from the artificial turf mat. Please stay off grass in front of mat. Golf tees can be placed into the artificial mat. The Professional Staff will monitor this closely. Failure to abide could lead to a suspension of Range Privileges.

**5. Golf Shop** The Golf Shop is open Tuesday through Sunday. Hours are as follows:

**6. Equipment Repairs** The Golf Shop is available for all Golf equipment repairs. With some simple preventative maintenance you can prolong the life of your investment. Let us help you enjoy the game with the proper adjustments and repairs. Options include regripping, reshafting, loft and lie adjustments, weight adjustments, lengthening and shortening, and reconditioning. Please stop in or call the Golf Shop to inquire about pricing.

**7. Golf Lessons** The Golf Staff is available for private, group and playing lessons, Tuesday - Sunday, throughout the year. Customize your lessons with video analysis and launch monitor technology. Whenever possible, it is recommended that lessons be scheduled in advance. The Staff also conducts Clinics for all Golfing Members.

**8. Caddies** Caddies are a traditional part of walking golf at the Club. Caddies are independent contractors and are to be paid directly. Some Caddie use is mandatory. During the golf season, at least one Caddie (if available) must be used in every foursome starting on the Spring Mill Course until 2:30pm, and for all tournament events. During the month of October, from the 1<sup>st</sup> to the 15<sup>th</sup>, use of a Caddie is mandatory until 2pm. From the 16<sup>th</sup> to the 31<sup>st</sup>, it is mandatory until 1:30pm. Regardless of tee time or course played, a group with two (2) or more Guests must have at least one (1) Caddie in their group. Exception: Any foursome in golf cars **consisting of Members only** shall have the option of playing without a Caddie.

During the off-season, it is suggested that a Caddie be used, if available. If you require a Caddie, it is recommended that you notify the Golf Shop in advance by calling 610-525-6000, ext. 3.

A Member may compensate a Caddie based upon the Caddie's level of performance and degree of satisfaction. We generally recommend the following for your consideration:

“A” Level Caddie (more than 2 years’ experience) - Khaki Colored Hat  
Rates: 9 Holes ..... \$30.00 (plus gratuity)  
18 Holes ..... \$50.00 (plus gratuity)  
Forecaddie ..... \$80.00 per group (plus gratuity)

“B” Level Caddie (less than 2 years’ experience) - Light Blue Colored Hat  
Rates: 9 Holes ..... \$25.00 (plus gratuity)  
18 Holes ..... \$45.00 (plus gratuity)  
Forecaddie ..... \$80.00 per group (plus gratuity)

Gratuity Guideline: The suggested range is \$5 to \$20 per bag, based on performance.

Please note, the only time a double bag Caddie will be assigned as an exclusive single Caddie to one Member is in the finals of the Club Championships or Stradley Cup. Refusing to share your Caddie in NON-FINALS (CC or Stradley) match is not acceptable and will not be tolerated if your opponent would like the same Caddie.

**9. Golf Cars** Golf cars are available for rental with the Caddie Master, and Members using golf cars must adhere to the posted rules. It is the responsibility of the Member to know the rules governing where the golf cars may be driven. The Member renting the golf car is responsible for seeing that no child without a current driver’s license drives the golf car, and that there are **no more than two occupants per golf car. Please keep all four tires of your golf car on the cart paths wherever possible, as maintaining turf along paths is very important.**

Children under the age of six are not permitted in a golf car. When approaching the green, you should always park your golf car thirty (30) feet (10 paces) from the green on the far side away from the approach. Golf cars are not permitted on the Practice Tee, around the Practice Green or at the Practice Hole.

Golf cars must be returned to the Golf Shop at sunset. Failure to abide by the golf car regulations may result in loss of golf car and/or Golf Privileges, as well as assuming responsibility for any resulting damages.

**10. Member Play** On the **Spring Mill Course**, players may carry their own golf bag **only after 2:30pm** on all days that the course is open during the golf season. During the month

of October, from the 1<sup>st</sup> to the 15<sup>th</sup>, golfers may carry their own bag after 2pm. From the 16<sup>th</sup> to the 31<sup>st</sup>, they may carry after 1:30pm. All golfers **must** check in at the Caddie Master/ Golf Shop area prior to starting, year-round. All play must start from the first tee unless authorized by the Golf Staff to do otherwise. During the off-season, a Member may carry his/her own bag at any time. Please avoid slow play, as it adversely affects the enjoyment of the game for other golfers.

On the **Centennial Nine**, players may walk and carry their own Golf bag at any time when the course is open **after checking in** at the Caddie Master/Golf Shop area. Golf cars, if available, will be provided for transportation to the Centennial Nine.

**Pull carts are not permitted at Philadelphia Country Club.** However, lightweight Golf bags are provided complimentary from the Caddie Master for those who would like a casual option.

**11. Guest Play** A Guest is welcome to use the golf facilities of the Club. The Member must accept responsibility for the conduct of his/her Guest(s) and their adherence to all Club rules. **All Guests must be registered in the Golf Shop prior to play.** A Guest may play five (5) times per fiscal year, excluding tournaments. Other than for an approved outing, a Member is limited to bringing no more than seven (7) Guests at one time to play golf, unless approval is granted by the Golf Chairman. All Members with Golf Privileges, excluding Non-Residents, are entitled to entertain Guests at a reduced fee under the Family & Friends Program. A reduced fee option may be exercised for a maximum of six (6) Guest rounds per year. **A Family & Friends rate must be designated at the time of registration.** Only one (1) Guest per foursome is permitted on Saturdays until 10am. Only one (1) Guest per foursome is permitted on Sundays and Holidays until 9am.

Each season Members have the opportunity to purchase a Guest Fee Package of either nine Guest rounds for \$975 or 18 Guest rounds for \$1,600. These discounted Guest rounds have to be purchased by May 1st and only three unused Guests rounds will carry over to the following season.

A Member may arrange for up to one (1) foursome of unaccompanied Guests by prior arrangement with the Golf Shop. All charges will be billed to the Member, and the Member is

responsible for the Guests' actions. A Member may bring Guest(s) on Centennial after 4pm for the special rate of \$50.00 per Guest, which includes the Guest(s) golf car fee. A child (Under 21) of a Resident, Senior or Intermediate Member with Golf or Wait List Privileges may bring a certified Junior Guest an unlimited number of times on Centennial at any time at no charge.

An Intermediate Member may bring a Guest, between the ages of 14-35, after 3pm daily for the special rate of \$60.00 per Guest. If applicable, full golf car fee would apply.

**12. Golf Attire** Neat and acceptable golf attire must be worn on the Golf Course and all Practice Areas. Members are responsible for their Guest's attire.

**Acceptable attire for Men:** Golf slacks or shorts that are no more than 4 inches above the knee. Men's shirts must have a traditional collar, turtleneck, or mock turtleneck. All shirts must be tucked in, and all caps must be worn with the bill of the cap facing forward. **Unacceptable attire for Men:** T-shirts, tank tops, V-neck shirts, cargo shorts, running shorts, tennis shorts, swim shorts, cutoffs, warm-ups, denim jeans or denim shorts.

**Acceptable attire for Ladies:** Golf slacks, capri pants, golf shorts or skirts which are no more than 4 inches above the knee. Women's blouses must have either sleeves or a collar. **Unacceptable attire for Women:** Golf shorts or skirts cut more than 4 inches above the knee, running shorts, fitness attire, cutoffs, warm-ups, denim jeans or denim shorts.

Members of PCC's Professional Staff are responsible for ensuring adherence to the above guidelines for proper attire. Appropriate golf shoes are required, with tennis shoes being permitted. Barefooted play is not permitted.

**Anyone who is inappropriately attired will not be permitted to use any of the Golf Facilities, including the Putting Green and Practice Areas.**

**13. Golf Shoes** The Club prohibits the use of metal, penetrating spikes and aggressive soft spikes on all three nine hole courses and Practice Areas. Please inform your Guests prior to arrival. The following areas can be slippery when wet: footbridges at holes #2, 5, 6, 11 and 17; grass slopes around ponds at holes #5, 6, 10, 11 and 17; steps at holes #11, 17 and 18; pathway leading to the dam at hole #17; grass slopes at Centennial hole #6; grass slopes that surround bunkers.

**14. Handicaps** All individual handicaps will be calculated in accordance with the USGA Handicap System (GHIN). A handicap index is available after at least five scores have been posted. The handicap index is used to calculate your course handicap. New handicaps will be computed on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> of each month during the Golf season. Any player who does not have an established handicap must play at a zero handicap in tournaments. In some events at the Club, and in the GAP (Golf Association of Philadelphia), a Golfer must have posted a minimum of ten (10) scores that Golf season to be eligible. For tournament play, a player shall use his handicap posted at the time the competition begins. If the tournament lasts longer than a week, then each player shall use their current handicap on the day of the match. The Handicap Committee may adjust any individual's handicap if they judge it not accurate.

If a player belongs to more than one club using the GHIN system, he/she must be registered under the same GHIN number so that all scores posted at every club will enter into their handicap computation. In order for a handicap to be a USGA handicap, a player must post all scores both Home and Away.

The annual GAP Fee of \$35.00 will be charged to each Member account at the start of the season. A personalized PCC bag tag is included in this fee.

**15. Hole-In-One Club** All Members and Spouses with Golf Privileges are automatically included in the Hole-In-One Club. One other player in the playing group must attest a hole-in-one to be eligible for benefits. Members/Guests in the Clubhouse receive one complimentary drink while the Golfer who made the hole-in-one remains in the Clubhouse. The Golfer and Members of his/her foursome, receive complimentary drinks, while the Golfer remains in the Clubhouse. All alcoholic beverage service at PCC, is subject to the rules stipulated in the PCC Responsible Alcohol Service Policy. When the Golfer leaves the Clubhouse, all free drinks cease. If the Golfer makes the hole-in-one while participating in a Member event, all event participants will receive one complimentary drink.

The Golf Shop Staff will order a complimentary plaque for the Member that makes the hole-in-one.

**16. Ladies' Golf Programs** Ladies and Certified Juniors with a USGA handicap index of 36.0 or less are eligible to join the Tuesday Lady Golfers (18-Holers). This group schedules a number of 18 hole competitions and events throughout the season. This group has full privileges of the Golf Course on Tuesdays until 11am, and as otherwise noted in the Annual Golf Book. Additional information about the program can be obtained by contacting the Tuesday Ladies' Golf Chair.

Any PCC Lady Member with an active Golf Privilege is eligible to join the Thursday Lady Golfers (9-Holers). Members interested in joining the nine hole program should contact the Thursday Ladies' Golf Chair. This group has full privileges until 10:30am on the designated course on Thursdays.

**17. Junior Golf** Children Golfers are those Golfers, age 6 and over, who have not reached their 21<sup>st</sup> birthday. Children under the age of 6 years-old are not permitted on the golf course or Practice Areas unless accompanied and supervised by a parent or responsible adult. A Golfer who has not earned his or her golf certification tag must be accompanied by an adult at all times when using the Golf Facilities. Certification tags are awarded to children who have demonstrated proficiency in golf, knowledge of the rules, and are responsible regarding golf course etiquette. Certified Juniors with an established handicap are eligible to compete in Men's and Ladies' events based on event availability. The PCC Golf Staff will offer many clinics, camps, and programs throughout the year for Juniors. Based on availability all programs will offer priority to Members with a Golf Privilege, then to Members with a Temporary Relinquished Golf Privilege, then to Juniors with a Golf Privilege, and finally to Non-Golf Members. There is a link on the Club's website that details the Junior Golf Program for the season. A child of a Resident, Senior or Intermediate Member with a Golf Privilege may bring a Junior Guest an unlimited number of times on Centennial at no charge.

**18. Golf Bag Storage** The Golf Shop provides bag storage, which includes club cleaning, for a seasonal rate. This helps the Member receive efficient service when arriving to play golf, especially on tournament days. All Members' golf bags must have identifying tags so the Staff can properly arrange golf cars, Caddies and hole assignments for daily play and tournaments. Members who do not store their clubs should drop their bags off at the bag drop area, and notify the Staff that they have arrived. If the Golf Shop is closed, a Member may retrieve a golf bag from the bag storage area by contacting the front desk and arranging a pick up.

**19. Storm Warning Policy** When severe weather and lightning activity is detected in the area, a horn will be sounded. **It is mandatory to discontinue play when the horn sounds. A two-tone signal indicates when severe weather is expected. All are advised to take shelter. An intermittent two-tone signal indicates that play can resume. Play is not to be resumed until the all clear signal is sounded. The Club wishes to emphasize that players have the right to stop play any time they feel there is imminent danger, even if not specifically authorized by a signal. In addition, Club rules state that Caddies may discontinue the round at their discretion for the same reason. When warned of an impending storm, players not close to the Clubhouse should immediately seek shelter.**

**20. Golf Outings** A Golf Outing requiring written request and Golf Chairman approval is defined as any group of Members, or Members and Guests, consisting of more than eight (8) players who play as a group by reason of their association with an organization other than the Club. The number of Club Members in the group does not change this rule. A dinner or an hors d'oeuvre reception may be required to be a part of an outing event. Outings consisting of 44 players or less will typically be held on Wednesdays after 1pm. Monday Outings require a guaranteed minimum of 100 players, and may not exceed 120 for 18-hole events. Play will start with a shotgun at 12:30pm. Monday Golf Outings may be requested up to a year in advance, with a limited number of dates available. Requests for 27-hole Monday Outings require a guaranteed minimum of 136 players, and may not exceed 180. Outing participants must abide by the same rules as the Members regarding attire, etiquette, pace of play, etc.; a complete summary of guidelines is available in the Administrative Office.

**21. Player Assistants** During peak playing times, "Player Assistants" will be available to provide help in a variety of ways. They are available to monitor the overall pace of play on the Course. When circumstances permit, they will assist players in locating balls as this can also help to speed up play. In case of emergencies, the Player Assistant has a first aid kit, an AED and a radio to call for help in serious emergencies. The Player Assistant has a rulebook as well as tees, pencils, scorecards, sunscreen, etc. The Player Assistant is your connection to the Clubhouse, Golf Shop, Bag Room and Golf Course Maintenance Personnel. If the Player Assistant does not happen to be in the area, and an emergency arises, note that there are emergency phones available at the Halfway House, Grounds Maintenance Facility and at the Restroom facility by the fourteenth green. Please feel free to contact the Player Assistant for help.

**22. Automated External Defibrillator Emergency** If a medical emergency presents itself the Club has several AED units available to assist. As stated in #21 the Player Assistant will have a unit on his or her golf car, in addition there are AED units available outside of the Caddie Master's office, in the Grounds building 1<sup>st</sup> floor entrance, in the Summer House, Squash Building, Fitness Center, and in the Main Coat Room. Please remember to get assistance first by calling the main Clubhouse at 610-525-6000 to report the location and type of emergency.

**23. Keep Pace Program** We want all golfers to enjoy their round, and we believe this can be done in less than four (4) hours. The Keep Pace Program is as follows: with a foursome teeing off every ten minutes, groups should maintain that interval throughout the round, and finish ten minutes apart at the 9<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> greens. If you are one of the first four groups to tee off, enjoy the privilege but set a brisk pace for the rest of us! **To remain eligible for play during one of the first four tee times, you will be expected to play your round in less than three (3) hours and forty-five (45) minutes. Subsequent groups are expected to play in approximately four (4) hours.** Records will be kept by the Golf Committee on all individuals in a slow play group. When a Member accumulates his second violation, he/she will be notified within approximately two weeks of that occurrence. The Member will be restricted from playing during the designated high volume periods during the first two full weeks following his/her notification; the designated high volume periods are weekdays from 11:30am to 1:30pm, weekends and Holiday mornings from the start of play until 10am. Subsequent slow play violations during the season will each result in the same restrictions. Further restrictions of playing privileges may be imposed by the Golf Committee if a Member chronically violates the Keep Pace Program guidelines. For Golf at Philadelphia Country Club to be a pleasurable experience for **all Members**, it is necessary that your Golf Committee be rigorous in the enforcement of reasonable pace of play rules. **No more than four players may play together at any time during the official Golf season.**

**24. Tournament Forfeits** Players who qualify for any match play bracket, and forfeit their match, are subject to a suspension of their privilege to compete in that event the following season.

**25. Cellular Phones** Talking on cellular phones is strictly prohibited on the golf course and in the parking area, except in the privacy of your automobile and designated phone rooms in the Clubhouse. While out on the golf course, silent data transmissions is acceptable if not affecting pace of play.

**26. Non-Golf Use** Running, jogging, walking, fishing and other forms of non-golfing use of the golf course by Members not playing golf are strictly prohibited during the golf season, which is April 1 to October 31. After golf season, such use of the course is permitted at the Member's own risk, and only when there are no golfers on the course. Cross country skiers should avoid skiing over green complexes. Fishing and ice skating on the ponds are **never** permitted.

**27. Pets** Are not permitted in the Clubhouse, on the golf course, or in any area of Club property at any time. Pets which serve as medical companions (i.e. seeing-eye companions, etc.) are an exception, and are always welcome.

**28. Monday Play** The golf course is open for Member play on non-outing Mondays beginning at 10:30am. Employees and Caddies are permitted to play after 11:30am. All Club rules and regulations are in effect, and there will be a Player Assistant monitoring play. Use of golf cars is not permitted for Monday play. Should you have Guests, and require Caddies, please contact the Caddie Master in advance.

**29. Tournament Applications and Eligibility** Tournament applications must be submitted by the entry closing date, which will be three (3) days prior for Member Tournaments and five (5) days prior for Member-Guest Tournaments. If the event is still not fully subscribed, open spots will be filled as applications are received. Limited Golf Members will be eligible to compete in the tournaments only if there is an open spot. If a Member is a PGA of America Professional and eligible to play in PCC Member events, they are only eligible for Net prizes. If a PGA Professional is participating as a Guest in a Member event, they must have a USGA Handicap. **Non-Golf Members and those on Temporary Relinquishment are not eligible to play in Club events.**

**30. Adopt-A-Hole** In an effort to assist with course maintenance during the golf season, we would like to encourage the continued involvement of the Membership in the Adopt-A-Hole program. By adopting a hole, you are requested to repair several extra ball marks, fill in any divots on tees and fairways, and pick up any misplaced litter. This will make our course more playable and a little neater. If your last name begins with the letter assigned to a specific hole, you have formally adopted each of those holes on the Spring, Mill and Centennial Nines. When you are playing any of the Courses, please take an extra few moments on your “adopted holes.”

# IMPORTANT TOURNAMENT NOTES

1. Men’s Criteria for Combination Tee Play

Any player whose combined age plus handicap equals 85+ can elect to play from the Combination Tees. Additionally, any player whose combined age plus handicap equals 95+ can elect to play from the Gold Tees. Players who move up will be subject to the applicable handicap adjustment from Section 9-3c of the USGA Handicap Manual.

Example: Players’ Age	Course Handicap	Combined Age+Hdcp	Option to Play White/Green	Option to Play Green	Option to Play Gold
62	23	85	Yes	Yes	No
75	20	95	Yes	Yes	Yes

As in the past, those players who meet the guidelines and wish to play from either set of Forward Tees should indicate their intentions on the event’s sign-up sheets. In the absence of such indication, players will be defaulted to the White Tees.

- 2. To participate in the Better Ball of Partners Tournament, Stradley Cup and Fall Classic a minimum of eight scores must be posted during the last 12 months. If the player does not have eight scores posted then his handicap will be adjusted down by one stroke. If the player has less than six posted scores, his handicap will be adjusted down by two strokes.
- 3. For all Ladies’ Championship events, tees will be determined in the Ladies’ Tournament Guidelines. In weekly events, competitors have the option of which tee they would like to play from. The USGA Handicap Manual will apply rule 3-5, to adjust handicap strokes from different tees for equal competition.
- 4. Entries for Member events can be done on the Club website at [www.philadelphiacc.net](http://www.philadelphiacc.net). Members may also register for events by calling the Golf Shop or emailing the Staff.
